
National Police Memorial Day 2025 is this Sunday!



Sunday 28th September is almost here, with only a few days to go before we gather at Coventry Cathedral to remember fallen police officers who gave their all to protect the communities they served.

Important information for those attending this year...

Car Parking is available at MSCP, Gosford Street, CV1 5DL



What three words location for the MSCP is https://w3w.co/steer.weds.stray

People who park within the MSCP must pay on arrival and the parking tariff for the day is £4. Parking payments is via the RingGo (Pay by Phone) app and the parking code is <u>57307</u>.

You will have to manually enter the car park code into the app. Signage for the MSCP payment code is provided within the car park itself.

There is capacity for 425 vehicles, and EV chargers are provided on the ground floor. Any EV users will need to download the Monta EV app to use these facilities. The power of the chargers is 7KwH.

Disabled Parking is available on Priory Row, CV1 5EX

There is additional parking at a multi-storey car park, Salt Lane, CV1 2GY

IMPORTANT: Unfortunately there will be major disruption on the roads this weekend, from Saturday 3am to Sunday 10pm.

- M6 closed in both directions between junctions 4 and 4A
- M42 junction 7A link to M6 southbound also closed
- Please follow the fully signed diversion route and allow more time for journey. More here.

Coach arrivals and parking

Coach parties can be dropped off outside the Cathedral and parking is available behind **Elm Bank**, **CV1 2LY**. Should this be full, there is additional coach parking 100 yards further up the road on **Mile Lane**, **CV1 2TU**.

All coach parties must be dropped off at the Cathedral by **12pm latest**.



Changing facilities for police officers who wish to change into uniform will be available in the University Hub, adjacent to the Cathedral.



There will be historic police vehicles on display outside the Cathedral - on the University Square and in the Cathedral ruins.

Force standards will be on display, with a Guard of Honour forming and a National Police Air Service flyover at approx. 12.40pm, depending on operational commitments.

NPMD shop

There will be a shop selling NPMD merchandise to raise funds for the charity. Stock up on commemoritive coins, ties, pin badges, pens, shopping trolly tokens and other merchandise.

The shop will be situated in the University's 'Hub' where we will be serving refreshments after the service, courtesy of Serve and Protect.

Personal belongings

There are no cloakroom facilities and we therefore ask that you do not bring excess luggage to the Cathedral. As usual there will be security checks and bag searches before entry.

Refreshments and toilet facilities

Refreshments will be available to buy in the University 'Hub' before the service. The post-event reception will also be held in the Hub, courtesy of Serve and Protect. Toilet facilities are in the Hub and available prior to, during, and after the service.

Police Roll of Honour Book of Remembrance

There will be three Books of Remembrance on display which has the names of all fallen police officers in the UK and Ireland. The book holds more than 5,000 names.

One book will be on display in the Cathedral before the service for you to view. It will then join the other two books for you to view in the University's 'Hub' where the post-service reception will take place. We will ensure one book is in a quieter space for families and colleagues to view and reflect. This will be set aside, with the union standard so that it is easily identifiable.
